

'A' for AM

- 1993, MNJ received the Order of Australia (AM) medal for services to Aboriginal art



'B' for Brisbane

- *Lightning Strikes* sculptures (metals, polyurethane & acrylic) comprise a 'curved' section for the travelling storm path with three crooked 'vertical' lightning strikes




'C' for Campfire Group

'F' for Five Stories

- Stories are: Possum, Flying Ant, Rainbow Serpent, Lightning & Kangaroo
- *Five Stories* was auctioned for AUD \$687,877, being the highest price achieved by a living Indigenous artist, at Sotheby's, London 2016



'F' for Forecourt

- Forecourt design was created during 1986-1987 based on MNJ painting *Possum and Wallaby Dreaming*
- 196m² mosaic comprising over 90,000 individual granite pieces selected specifically to match colours in MNJ's painting



- Design re-interprets linear sand-painting pattern




'M' for Mt Singleton


'T' for Telstra NATSIAA




