Exhibiting contemporary social commentary works from Queensland artists including Vincent Serico, Ian Waldron, Fiona Omeenyo, Archie Moore and Tony Albert. The exhibition also includes a 4.5m collaborative painting from Wangkatjungka in northern Western Australia.
