


Some People are Stories

In 2007 Michael Eather, Director of FireWorks Gallery and close friend to Vincent discussed the concept of a Print Folio featuring his key images and texts that might form a legacy for Vincent's family, as his health was failing. Sadly in 2008 Vincent passed away with a cancer mid publication and did not get to see the final product.

In 2009 a limited edition (of 39 A1 size bound folios and 10 A1 sized boxed sets) titled: **Some people are stories** was produced and officially launched at the Cairns Indigenous Art Fair in 2010. These have since been collected privately and publicly including: The State Library of Queensland and the National Library of Australia.

Much more than simply an Artist's book, this unique product remains a collector's item with distinctive aluminum covers to help preserve the quality archival prints. Each set and folio consists of **22 reproductions**; a **legend of stories** along with **interview notes and quotes** by Vincent collected between 1993 and 2007.


